Jdg 1:3 And Judah said unto Simeon his brother, Come up with me into my lot, that we may fight against the Canaanites; and I likewise will go with thee into thy lot. So Simeon went with him.

In a census recorded in Numbers 26, Judah with 76500 had the most fighting fit men above twenty one years old, and Simeon had the least with 22200. Yet, we see Judah forming a league with the Simeon to fight against the Canaanites. What are the lessons for us?

1. CO-OPERATION – They cooperated and worked together. It was a true spirit of brotherhood. Both might have failed had they acted alone. But unity is strength and their united effort ensured them victories in their encounters.

The same applies to Christian work. The church work cannot be done by a single person. If a church only has its preacher who is working, it is destined to fail. Paul wrote: "For we are labourers together with God," (1 Cor 3:9). Paul worked with Barnabas, Silas, Mark, Epaphroditus and others. Every Christian is a living stone that builds up a spiritual house (1 Pet 2:5). A single stone is not a house. A stone by itself is useless. But when we gather the stones together, we can build a house. Likewise, much work will be done when brethren work together.

2. UNITY – Before Judah and Simeon could co-operate, they must first be united. They must share the same goal and interest.

"It is an example to our brethren, and a witness before the world to the unity of God's people. Spiritual men above all others should not first ask, "What is our right?" but, "What is our obligation, and how can we best illustrate the spirit of the Master?" (Pulpit Comm).

Our Lord prayed for unity (John 17:21). The apostle Paul wrote: "Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing,

and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment" (1 Cor 1:10).

Barnes' comment on 1 Cor 1:10: "The church was to be regarded as one and indivisible, and not to be rent into different factions, and ranged under the banners of different leaders."

Let us always remember and practice Phil 2:2: "Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind."

3. BEARING – Judah was the strongest but he begged Simeon who was the least among all the tribes to join him in the war against the Canaanites. Why didn't Judah engage Dan who had a much bigger army than Simeon? I can think of one good reason: Judah was helping Simeon.

Perhaps Judah saw that Simeon, being the weakest, would not be able to do it alone, and so he joined himself to Simeon to help him. It was brotherly love and affection. Brother Judah saw that Simeon needed help and he offered himself to him.

Paul exhorts: "We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves" (Rom 15:1).

Judah with his 76500 warriors had no problem defeating the Canaanites. But when he looked at his brother Simeon, he said, "This brother needs help." So he said to Simeon: "Come with me into my lot, and then I will go with thee into thine."

The scripture says that we are to bear one another's burden (Gal 6:2). On this occasion Judah lost nothing, and Simeon secured a powerful ally to ensure success in his conquests. I love this exhortation from Paul: "Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others" (Phil 2:4).

Judah does not care about his rights; he cares about his obligations. And one of his obligations is to care for his weaker brother. He has brotherly love for his brethren. He shows us that the strong needs to bear the infirmities of the weak.

"Lend a hand to help a brother who is struggling hard and true. Don't forget that in the valley there is someone needing you."

Judah called on Simeon and they worked together in brotherly love and unity. Let us always remember the brotherly love we should have for one another: "Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another" (Rom 12:10).



What Will Build a Strong Church?

Not sensationalism! Not gimmicks! Not more committees, mere programs or a "fun and games" emphasis! These things may be "right-on" for civic clubs, social clubs and country clubs, but not for the Lord's church! What does it take to build a strong church? I believe with all my heart that the following things are essential!

- Strong Bible preaching and teaching! God's Word, when it is disseminated plainly, forcefully, uncompromisingly and yet kindly, will build up! Paul said, "I commend you unto God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up..." (Acts 20:32).
- Exemplary leadership! Men who make themselves "examples to the flock" and who are careful in tending it (1 Peter 5:2-3) will build a strong church. To grow, the church must have quality leadership—men who know how to lead and will do so!
- **Christian living on the part of every member!** Unimpeachable conduct clearly evidenced in the lives of Christians will illuminate the way for many in the realm of darkness (Matthew 5:16; Philippians 2:15).
- **Congregational warmth and love!** The fellowship of the Lord's church should be so sweet and precious that the whole community takes notice and observes, "See how they love each other!" Without this, a congregation will never be what God would have it to be!
- **Compassionate hearts!** The church of Christ needs to be known as the most tender-hearted bunch of people in all the world, ready and willing to help all, but especially those of the household of faith (Galatians 6:9-10).

- **Evangelistic fervor!** The emphasis of the early church was soul-winning! The church will grow when we cease not to "teach and to preach Jesus as the Christ" every day, wherever we have opportunity (Acts 5:42)!
- An "I want to serve" attitude permeating the congregation! People serving the Lord because they love Him, and they want to serve—and not out of a spirit of drudgery—will build a strong church.
- An atmosphere of happiness, friendliness, cordiality and hospitality! No stranger should ever come into the midst of the Lord's church without being graciously greeted and welcomed by a happy, friendly membership! We must reach out to others and not just "visit" with friends only.

It is my conviction that these ingredients will build a strong church! I pray fervently that all eight points will become a reality in every congregation more than ever before!
