David, The Man After God's Own Heart

Sermon outline by bro Jimmy Lau

INTRODUCTION: David, The Man After God's Own Heart 1 Sam 13:14

- 1. Overview of David's Life Faith, Courage, Sin, Repentance.
- 2. Why David was called a man after God's own heart? Acts 13:22 "I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will."
- ❖ Observation: David's life was a portrait of success and failure, and the biblical record highlights the fact that David was far from perfect. But what made David a cut above the rest was that his heart was pointed toward God. He had a deep desire to follow God's will and do "everything" God wanted him to do. Such was a man after God's own heart

DISCUSSION: DAVID THE MAN AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART

A: HOW WAS DAVID THE MAN AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART?

- 1. *A FAITHFUL HEART* David had absolutely faith in God.
 - i. As seen in his meeting with Goliath. 1 Sam 17:45
- ii. As seen in his prayer life. Psalm 55:17
- iii. As seen in his love for God's law. Psalm 119:97
- iv. As seen in his writings. Psalm 23:1
- v. As seen in his worship. Psalm 42:1
- vi. As seen in his desire to build a temple for God. 2 Sam 7:2
- 2. *A SUBMISSIVE HEART* David submitted to God's commandments. He would not kill Saul because Saul was God's anointed. 1 Sam 24:6
- 3. A HEART FOR GOD'S LAW David absolutely loved God's Law. Psa 119:97
- 4. A GRATEFUL HEART. David gave thanks often. He was truly thankful. Psa 100:4.
- 5. *A HUMBLE HEART*. After his incredible defeat of Goliath, David was favoured by all Israel. He became a member of Saul's royal court. Still, he considered himself totally unworthy to

marry the king's daughter (I Sam 18:18, 23-24). He knew God had blessed him, and he felt undeserving. He esteemed himself as nothing more than a dead dog or a flea (I Sam 24:14). He honestly felt that he was too insignificant to threaten Saul's position. Eventually, when he did become king, he continued to reflect godly humility: "Who am I, O Lord GOD? and what is my house, that thou hast brought me hitherto?" (2 Sam 7:18).

- 6. *A REMORSEFUL HEART*. David was truly repentant. Psalm 51 is David's prayer of repentance to God: "For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me" (Psalm 51:3).
- 7. *A PATIENT HEART*. David could have gotten the throne earlier if he had killed Saul, but he didn't. He knew that God would fulfil His plan for him if he patiently endured. 1 Sam 24:10
- 8. *A MAGNANIMOUS HEART*. Twice David had a chance to kill Saul but he did not (1 Sam 24:4-5; 26:9, 11). He wept when learned of Saul's death (2 Sam 1:17-19).
- 9. *A GENEROUS HEART.* David would not offer to God anything that cost him nothing. 2 Sam 24:24
- 10. **A SERVANT HEART**. David gave himself completely to serve God. He addressed himself as a "servant" (Psa 19:11) God called him "My servant David" (2 Sam 7:5).

B. BE A MAN AFTER GODS OWN HEART

- i. A man after God's own heart isn't perfect. 1 John 1:8
- ii. A man after God's own heart seeks to actively live in obedience to God. John 14:15
- iii. A man after God's own heart responds properly when confronted with his sin. 1 John 1:9
- iv. A man after God's own heart is concerned with spiritual things. Php 2:20-21
- v. A man after God's own heart loves and respects God's law. Psa 119:105
- vi. A man after God's own heart has a servant heart. 1 Sam 3:10
- vii. A man after God's own heart has a magnanimous heart; he does not hold a grudge. He forgives readily. Matt 5:44; Eph 4:31
- viii. A man after God's own heart is faithful. Heb 11:6

C. QUESTIONS FOR YOUR CONSIDERATIONS - HOW IS YOUR HEART?

- i. Do you have a heart like David?
- ii. Would God say of you as he said of David, "My servant David"?
- iii. Would God point you out as an example: "Hast thou considered my servant Job?" Job 1:8

CONCLUSION

- i. David has faults. David has afflictions. David accepts when God says NO. David continues to have faith in God. David loves God's Law and sought to follow it exactly. As a man after God's own heart, David is a role model for all of us.
- ii. What is God looking for? He is looking for men and women whose hearts are His completely. Micah 4:6
- iii. What will God say about you?
- iv. Which of the areas mentioned above need your greatest attention for improvement?



A Lesson from Jeremiah 37-39

The king of Babylon, Nebuchadrezzar (also spelled Nebuchadnezzar in other texts) was making plans to attack Jerusalem. Since Babylon was the world's superpower of the day, this was of great concern to the residents of Jerusalem. The king in Jerusalem at that time was Zedekiah. Zedekiah had been very disobedient to God. God sent the Babylonians to Jerusalem as punishment for his disobedience.

Zedekiah was very concerned about the intelligence reports that he had received. Babylon was indeed preparing a mass attack on his city. He did the wisest thing that he could do. He called Jeremiah and asked him to pray to God for the country. This was a very smart move! Most people would have called for the generals and colonels to ask them for a battle plan!

Unfortunately, Jeremiah had bad news for Zedekiah. God **intended** for the Babylonians to punish Jerusalem for its sins. The answer to Zedekiah's prayer was to surrender to the Babylonians! Zedekiah had received the answer to his prayer, but it was not the answer he wanted! Since it was not the answer for which he was hoping, should he obey?

Instead of obeying the Lord (which he was not in the habit of doing), he allowed Jeremiah to be thrown into the dungeon by the rulers of the city. After Jeremiah had been in jail for a long while, Zedekiah called for him and asked him again, "Is there any word from the Lord?" Jeremiah said, "There is: for, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon." Jeremiah told him the truth once again. Zedekiah treated Jeremiah a little better for a while, but later allowed the city rulers to put him in another dungeon where Jeremiah sank in the mire!

Jeremiah was about to die in this horrible place when one of Zedekiah's eunuchs begged him to get Jeremiah out of there. Zedekiah, once again, removed Jeremiah from prison and asked him if there was word from God. Jeremiah told him once again that if he refused to surrender to the Babylonians that he would be punished, and the city would be burned!

Zedekiah did not obey. Nebuchadnezzar attacked the city, killed Zedekiah's children before his eyes and then put out his eyes! Then the city was burned, just like God said it would be!

Do we only obey God when it suits us? Have you received the answer to your prayers but are unwilling to obey? Shouldn't we obey God in **all** things?
