2Th 1:12 That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

What's in a name? What's so great about a family name? The answer is obvious: a family name means a lot. It is so important that a father will tell his children: "Don't disgrace the family name." If a member in the family committed a crime and is sent to jail, he disgraces his family name.

A family's name speaks of its identity, traits, character, image, and even the business it is doing. Take for an example, the royal family of England. Every member of that family has to uphold a certain image. But what happens when Prince William has a brother who is often in the news for the wrong reasons? It brings shame to the family's name.

The name of our Lord Jesus Christ is a name that is above every name (Phil 2:9). It is by that name that we have been called (James 2:7). It is the same name that we called on for salvation (Rom 10:9, 13). It is the same name that we have put on; the name CHRISTIAN. It is the very name that we should glorify: **That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you** (2 Thess 1:12).

The name of Jesus Christ is our spiritual family name. The name speaks of an identity, a character, an image and a business. I have not heard of anyone who has rebuked another person in the name of any other religion other than the name of Christian. I have heard them said: "Ha, call yourself a Christian and you do this kind of thing." I have never heard them said that to any other religion.

You see, the name of Christ is the name we have been given and identify with (Acts 11:26). We are Christians and we carry His name. Hence Paul said that name is to be glorified in us.

How does one glorify the name of Christ?

- 1. When our **Faith** is growing: *We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet,* **because that your faith groweth exceedingly** (2 Thess 1:3a).
- 2. When our **Love** grows: We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth (2 Thess 1:3).
- 3. When our **Good Works** abound: Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your **good works**, and glorify your Father which is in heaven (Matt 5:16).
- 4. When we are **Bearing Fruits** in our lives: *Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit;* so shall ye be my disciples (John 15:8).
- 5. When we keep ourselves **Pure and Holy**: For ye are bought with a price: therefore **glorify God in your body, and in your spirit**, which are God's (1 Cor 6:20).

6. When we **Bear the Fruit of the Spirit**: But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no

law (Gal 5:22-23).

The name of the Lord Jesus is the end we should aim for in everything we do and desire, that God and Christ in all things may be glorified. Our good works should so shine before men that others may glorify God, that Christ may be glorified in and by us. We should not be seeking our own glory but the glory of Christ.

Let the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ be the one great aim above all other motives. THE GREAT END OF THE CHRISTIAN VOCATION IS TO GLORIFY THE NAME OF CHRIST. The Christian honours Christ by glorifying His name.

Are you glorifying the name of Christ? Is the name of Christ glorified in you?





Is That What You Meant to Say?

An insurance agent was writing a policy for a cowboy. "Have you ever had any accidents?" the agent asked. "No, not really," replied the cowboy. "A horse threw me off and kicked me in the ribs once, and I got bit a couple of times by a rattlesnake, but that's about it." "Don't you call those accidents?" demanded the agent. "Oh no," said the cowboy, "They did them things on purpose!"

It occurs to me that many things that appear to be accidents, or that we pretend are accidents, are actually intended outcomes. Sin is seldom if ever accidental. We may say that we "didn't mean to do it" or "didn't mean to say it," but, most of the time, that isn't really true. And, even if we didn't mean to do it or say it, surely the tempter meant for us to. Righteousness isn't an accident either. Jesus didn't accidentally live a sinless life. It took purpose of heart to resist temptation and do right at every turn.

Barnabas encouraged Christians that "with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord" (Acts 11:23). Paul commended Timothy because he had "carefully followed" Paul's "doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance" (II Timothy 3:10). The life of a Christian is truly a purpose-driven life. It is lived with a sense of purpose, by those who choose to do right on purpose.

This applies to every aspect of our lives, including our speech. We will not say the right things accidentally. We must choose to say them. In Psalm 17:3 David wrote, "You have tested my heart; You have visited me in the night; You have tried me and have found nothing; I have purposed that my mouth shall not transgress." David was right before God because he had determined to control his mouth. We must also control our speech if we are to be acceptable to God. The Bible says that "If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion is useless" (James 1:26).

We are to be thoughtful and purposeful with everything we say. Proverbs 15:28 states that, "The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil." The righteous man doesn't just say whatever comes into his mind. He"studies how to answer!" The New Testament commands, "Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers" (Ephesians 4:29).

Yet how often do we just talk without thinking about the effect of our words? In the Book of Job, Job's three friends had a lot to say to him that was pretty useless. Of them and their words Job says, "I have heard many such things; Miserable comforters are you all! Shall words of wind have an end? Or what provokes you that you answer?" (Job 16:2-3). One paraphrased translation of this has, "I've had all I can take of your talk. What a bunch of miserable comforters! Is there no end to your windbag speeches? What's your problem that you go on and on like this?" (MSG). Job's friends, though intelligent men, had not chosen to speak words that would have a positive effect.

Let us all give thought to the impact of our words. Words are powerful, and they will not be a power for good unless we purpose to make them so. Let's do our best to make sure that what we say is what we mean to say, and that what we mean to say is good.


