2Ki 2:13 He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan.

We have here an account of the translation of Elijah. Elijah was about to be taken up to heaven. Elisha had only one request from his master: "**Let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me**" (2 Kgs 2:9).

Elisha asked for no worldly advantage, but for spiritual power to discharge his office. He requested for a "double portion" of his master's spirit. He knew the work ahead of him was great and difficult. He knew his own strength and weakness. He needed double dose of his master's spirit to do the same thing that his master had done.

Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind. The only item he left was his mantle which he left for Elisha. Elisha returned to Jordan, and with this mantle he smote the waters as Elijah had done and the waters parted and he walked over to the other side. From that time forward, Elisha took the place of his master.

Elisha took the mantle up, not as a sacred relic to be worshipped, but as a significant garment to be worn. He wanted to be like his master. He had served and matured spiritually under Elijah's direction through several major events. It's time he followed in his master's footsteps.

There are some who left behind a formidable example that their successors find it hard to fit in. Our beloved sister Baby Tan is a perfect example as a preacher's wife. She did such a wonderful job as a preacher's wife that we have yet to find one who can match her example. She left such a big mantle that many find it too big to fit in.

She is approaching eighty-eight years old. She was at personal work tracting session last Saturday. Where are our more able bodied younger men and women?

During the restoration period, the Lord's church produced many men who were truly lovers of God's word. They spent hours each day diligently studying the word of God. They were fantastic preachers, debaters and writers. I have yet to see replicas of such men.

We do well if we can learn from faithful servants of God and put on their mantles. Elijah served and honoured his God with all his heart, mind and soul. Elisha took on his mantle and served God with the same zeal and diligence.

When a young brother Franklin Camp learned that the respected elderly brother Gus Nichols studied five hours a day on his bible, he decided that if brother Nichols needed five hours each day, he needed to study six hours a day, and for most of fifty years, he woke up early to get to the study where he did the work that enriched his life and preaching. He had a mantle that he wanted to fit in and so he disciplined himself to get himself fitted in.

Young men, if you want to preach and teach like those faithful old preachers, you need to work hard on it. You simply have to put in hours and not minutes into your daily bible study. You have to put in effort to study the bible every day and not only when you are preparing a sermon or lesson. You have to really exercise yourself to godliness (1 Tim 4:7-8).

Brethren, anything that is worth doing is worth doing well. It may cost you much time and energy. You may have to sacrifice some sleep to do it. Solomon says: "Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might" (Eccl 9:10).

The Hebrews writer exhorts: "That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises" (Heb 6:12).

Those faithful brethren of old are our examples. They left behind their mantles. Are you able to fit into their mantles? You cannot alter their mantles. BUT YOU CAN ALTER YOURSELF! Think about it.
